III. Mark M:

- Clean Boats / Clean Water

 - 6 Inspectors from Des Moines Lake Association
 - Looking for volunteers to get trained/ get trained - get a shirt

 - We can see licenses plate from video
 - County Law: Must spray boats going in and out of the lake
 - Visitors to your cabin: make sure they clean their boats thoroughly,
 - Great care is needed in buying and bring boats and docks from other lakes

 - Reminders for Clean Boats, Quiet hours
- Beetles
 - We are now raising beetles to help with Purple Loosestrife
