**I. Reading of Last Year Minutes: Malinda**

- Approved

**II. Speaker**

- Jason Towne- lake zoning
- Campground rules changed, harder now in Burnett Co, Zoning RR1(150 ft width), RR2 (200 ft), RR3 (300 ft) 5 acres
- New max units 150
- No campground on Long Lake
- Must get rezoned to have campground larger than 25 units
- Building / land use permits
  - Additions
  - Stairways / walkways / patio / deck
  - Shed garage over 100 ft
  - Driveway impervious surface
  - Filling and grading 300ft from lake – 50 ft from high water mark
  - Boat houses – can rebuild in same footprint (35 ft tall), dry or wet boathouse
  - Set back 75 ft from lake
  - 200 ft open side construction
  - New boathouses look up new rules
  - All reports are kept secret.
