3. Dave Foote:

• Loon platforms on the lake 5/07. Mark M, Dave F, & John Hertensteiner.

- Loons not on north or middle section platform, seem to be searching on shore areas to nest. 2 Eggs on south end platform ~ all nests have been swarmed with black flies.
- New styrofoam needed in 2024 for one nest, strapping at base of all nests in good shape.
- Dave read information on the Fall, 2022 Burnett County Fish Study done on Long Lake.
 Dave requested study information be posted on the LLA website (and perhaps on the LLA FB page?)

4. Dave Bjarnason:

• Dave not present. Steve H. read email from Dave regarding his request for new Loon Ranger to step in and replace him. Email information included what the Loon Ranger does in the program, also read to group by Steve. H.

5. Mark Michel

- Clean Boats/Clean Water: station at landing for spraying, cameras working and being monitored. Thanks to those that are signing up for time slots at the landing washing station.
